EXAMPLE - MATH

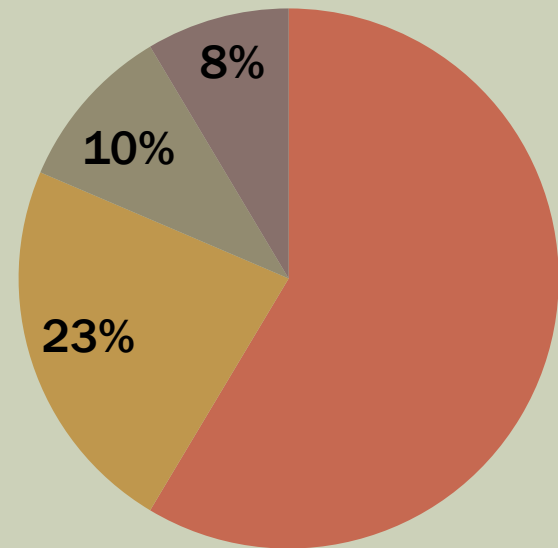
1. $63 - 23$
