To: Parents of Home-Schooled Children with IEPs

Harrison Elementary School District has a duty under federal legislation entitled Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA 2004) to seek out and evaluate students suspected of having educational disabilities and provide appropriate service. Under IDEA 2004, the Harrison Elementary School District is required to consult with parents of homeschooled students who have IEPs. A consultation meeting will be held on Tuesday, May 24, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. at Harrison School Dist. 36, 6809 McCullom Lake Road, IL 60097.

The following topic will be discussed during the consultation process:

- How, where, and by whom special education and related services will be provided for home school children with disabilities, including a discussion of types of services, including direct services and alternate service delivery mechanisms.
